SUPPLEMENTARY REASONS

[1] In our Reasons for Decision dated March 6, 2006, pursuant to s. 51.7(4) of the *Courts of Justice Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. C. 43, (“the Act”), we recommend that the Attorney General compensate Justice Douglas for his costs for legal services incurred in relation to the complaint against him. As well, we asked for submissions from his counsel and from presenting counsel in respect to the amount of compensation so that we could indicate the amount of compensation to be paid as required by s. 51.7(5) of the Act.

[2] Justice Douglas has incurred legal fees for his counsel’s services in the amount of \$49,149.08. We have examined the detailed accounts submitted by his counsel and we

are satisfied that the fees are reasonable. Moreover, presenting counsel has consented to our approval of costs for Justice Douglas' legal services in this amount.

[3] Accordingly, we recommend that the Attorney General compensate Justice Douglas for his costs for legal services in the amount of \$49,149.08.
