[1] By reasons dated December 20, 2018, we dismissed the complaint against Justice

Donald McLeod. The Courts of Justice Act, R.S.O. 1980, c.C43, s. 51.7(5), provides that

where a complaint is dismissed, the Panel is required to recommend to the Attorney

General that the judge be compensated for costs of his legal representation. Section

51.7(7) provides the Panel with discretion to recommend all or part of the judge's costs

for legal services.

[2] Justice McLeod's counsel has provided the Panel with a detailed outline of legal

costs and disbursements totaling \$81,265.96 inclusive of HST and disbursements. We

have reviewed that outline. Presenting Counsel advises the Panel that, in her view, the

request is reasonable. We agree.

[3] Accordingly, we recommend to the Attorney General that Justice McLeod be

compensated in the amount of \$81,265.96 inclusive of HST and disbursements for the

legal costs he incurred in this matter.
